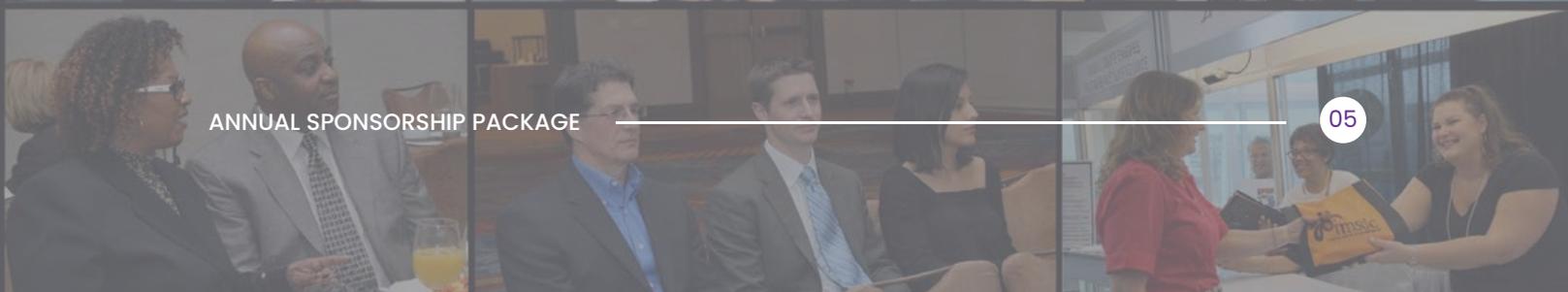

# SPECIAL PROGRAM SPONSORSHIP

In September 2021, Mid-States MSDC launched the Accelerate 100+ Program (A100+), one of the largest and most ambitious capacity-building initiatives in the National Minority Supplier Development Council network. Designed to significantly expand economic access for diverse businesses, the program equips participants with the tools, resources, and support needed to compete at the next level.

In October 2022, the inaugural cohort celebrated the graduation of 112 minority-owned businesses. A100+ is a comprehensive program that combines education, coaching, mentoring, and one-on-one advisory support with increased access to capital, contract opportunities, and strategic business collaborations.

Participants progress through structured stages of preparation, each focused on strengthening critical areas of business readiness and long-term growth. Upon successful completion, business owners receive a Certificate of Entrepreneurship from the Indiana University Kelley School of Business.

# Accelerate 100+

## Program Impact – At a Glance

- 284 diverse entrepreneurs have completed the program across six cohorts.
- Participants have secured a combined \$4.86 million in contracts and new business.
- More than 150 entrepreneurs earned certification in Business Strategy from the Indiana University Kelley School of Business.
- The program has supported 141 jobs with 60 jobs retained and 81 new jobs created
- A100+ focuses on five critical business challenges:
  - Adapting to modern business challenges
  - Keeping pace with technological advances
  - Competing in a globalized economy
  - Navigating increased competition

Each session combines expert-led instruction with a fireside chat format to encourage practical learning, peer engagement, and applied insight.
